Mission Statement

The mission of the North Dakota Community Foundation is to improve the quality of life for North Dakota’s citizens through charitable giving and promoting philanthropy.

About the North Dakota Community Foundation

The North Dakota Community Foundation was incorporated in 1976. NDCF is an IRS designated 501(c)(3) statewide, public, nonprofit, tax-exempt corporation that receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.

NDCF was formed by a group of concerned citizens who were looking for a general purpose charitable vehicle to build endowment to support important needs for communities and projects all across the state. Initial support for the Foundation came from the Otto Bremer Foundation (now the Otto Bremer Trust), the Northwest Area Foundation, the Norwest Bancorporation, the North Dakota Bremer Banks and the Bush Foundation.

NDCF has continued to grow and flourish over the years thanks to the support of thousands of individuals and businesses who want to make North Dakota a better place to live, work, and play.

National Standards

The National Standards Seal represents official confirmation from the Community Foundations National Standards Board that NDCF has met the most rigorous standards for community foundations. The seal affirms NDCF’s commitment to financial security, transparency, and accountability and says that our grantmaking includes an open, competitive process designed to address the changing needs of our community.

This structure ensures that the North Dakota Community Foundation is truly the people of North Dakota’s Foundation.

Since its founding, NDCF has been guided by leaders who have demonstrated integrity, consistency, and transparency. A steadfast belief in the resilience of North Dakotans — and a commitment to building strong relationships — has served as the foundation of our organization and helped shape it into something truly special for the people of our state.

One of those great NDCF leaders is Kevin Dvorak, who worked for this organization for 37 years, serving as its President & CEO for most of that time. The big change in 2025 for NDCF was the announcement that Kevin would be retiring at the end of the year.

Kevin led NDCF through a variety of challenges and opportunities and the organization grew substantially under his leadership (you can see some of the highlights of his tenure with NDCF on pages 8 & 9). He did so with the support and guidance of experienced leaders on our NDCF board, numerous other mentors and partners who believed in the mission of this organization, and by constantly keeping our core values in mind in every decision: That face-to-face is the best way to connect with people. That lasting change happens on the micro level, not with “one-size-fits-all” programs. That outside “experts” don’t bring as much to the table as those on the ground who actually do the work. That we need to always be transparent in our work and consistent in our service to our donors, grantees, and communities.

As we enter a new era under the leadership of President and CEO Steve Lipp, those same core values continue to guide the Foundation forward. By maintaining existing relationships and building new ones, NDCF remains committed to serving North Dakota one donor, one relationship, and one community at a time. Our belief in doing things the right way — with personal connection, trust, and long-term commitment — has helped create an organization that truly belongs to the people of North Dakota.

As you read this annual report and see the more than 1,600 grants awarded throughout the state in 2025, we hope you will recognize the meaningful difference these investments make in the lives of our citizens.

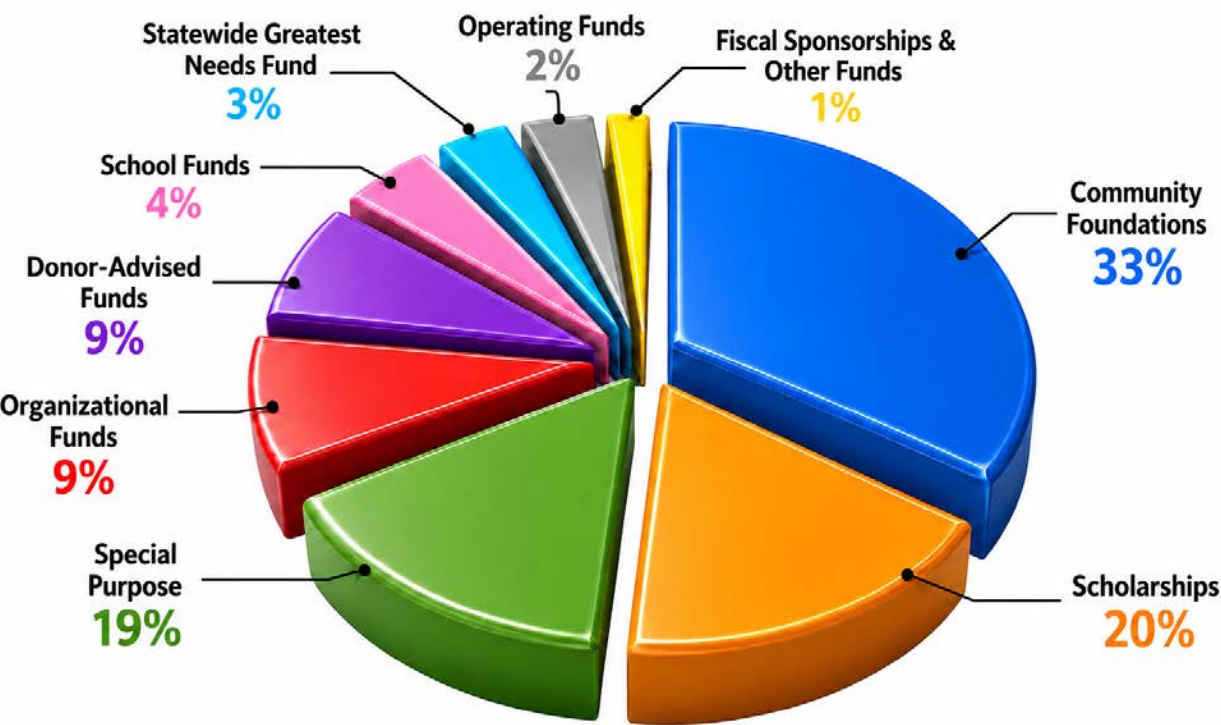

NDCF 2025 At-A-Glance

Total Assests by Fund Type

Our \$188 million in total assets are held in the following types of funds:



2,704 gifts, totaling more than \$22.6 million to NDCF funds in 2025!

More than \$817,000 awarded in scholarships to North Dakota youth and 12 NEW scholarship funds started in 2025, including the Cindy Schreiber-Beck Memorial Scholarship Fund.

59 new funds started at NDCF in 2025 to improve the quality of life in our state, including the Washburn River View Cemetery Endowment Fund.

More than \$11.1 million in grants and charitable disbursements for projects and programs all across the state, including a grant from the Carrington Community Endowment Fund to the NDSU Extension - Foster County for a Horticultural Therapy Program for seniors and nursing home residents. "The project was a resounding success, bringing joy to residents, staff, and visitors alike," said Foster County Extension Agent Jeff Gale.



Highlights from 2025!

NDCF was pleased to be a sponsor of Nonprofit Day at the Capitol in February. President & CEO Kevin Dvorak and Development Director Kara Geiger interacted with legislators and other nonprofit leaders and shared information about our mission.



Steve Lipp was hired as the next President & CEO of NDCF and began on May 1 working alongside Kevin Dvorak during a months-long transition. He assumed full leadership duties at the end of the year when Kevin officially retired.

The Freeman Foundation partnered with NDCF to provide \$50,000 in grants to organizations working with food security in the state. Grant recipients included the Bismarck Senior Center, the Stark County Council on Aging, Valley Senior Services, the Great Plains Food Bank, and the Grand Forks Senior Center (pictured, with NDCF employees Robin Salander and Amy Stromsodt delivering the check.)



The Otto Bremer Trust again selected NDCF to serve as their philanthropic partner to distribute \$1 million from their 2025 OBT Community Responsive Fund in North Dakota. Twenty organizations across the state received checks. Kevin Dvorak was hired to be a Program Officer for the North Dakota Community Foundation in 1989 and continued to work for the organization for the remainder of his career.



When Dr. Richard Timmins retired, Kevin succeeded him as President & CEO, assuming the mantle on January 1, 1995. He became a Certified Financial Planner in April of 1999 to better serve the foundation and led the organization through many challenges and opportunities over the next 30 years. He became a trusted expert in the nonprofit community in North Dakota and a leader for the industry.



Kevin officially retired on December 31, 2025. During his tenure as President, the organization grew from **\$6 million** to **\$188 million** in assets and from two employees to 11, with offices in Bismarck, Dickinson, Larimore, and Wahpeton.



We are indebted to Kevin for his great leadership as well as his commitment to the values and mission of the North Dakota Community Foundation.

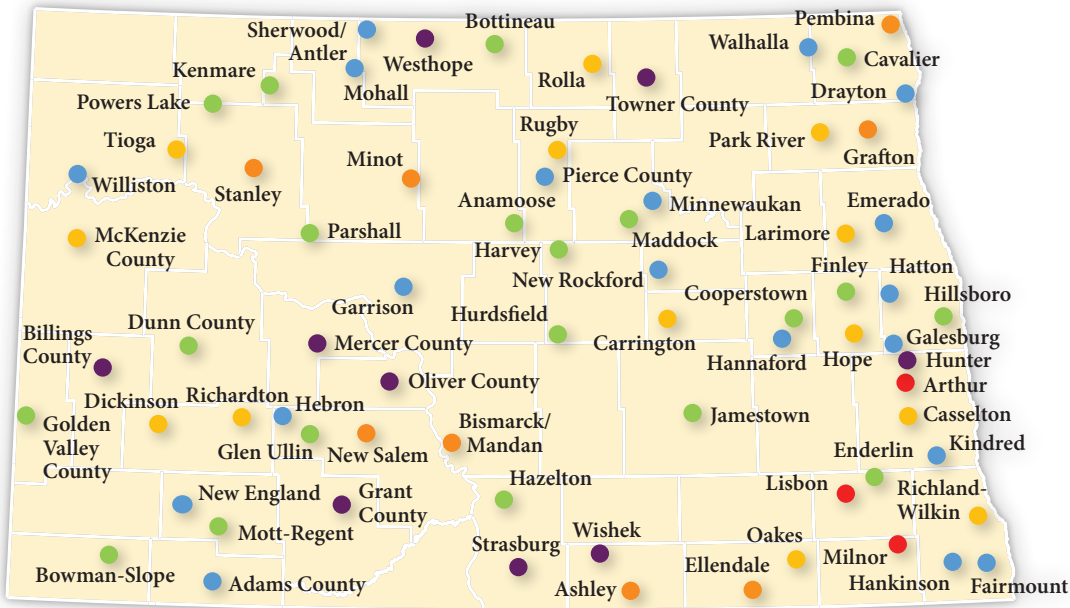

Our Community Foundations

Our local community foundations are the signature program of the North Dakota Community Foundation, and specifically our community endowment funds. NDCF added three new community endowment funds in 2025, bringing the total to 72, supporting different communities, counties, or areas in the state. These funds each have an advisory committee made up of local residents that lead fundraising efforts and recommend grant awards. These grants fund projects and programs that greatly improve the quality of life in their part of the state. It’s an excellent example of local residents investing their charitable dollars in their own hometown, supporting their own nonprofit organizations and needs. Here are some highlights from 2025:



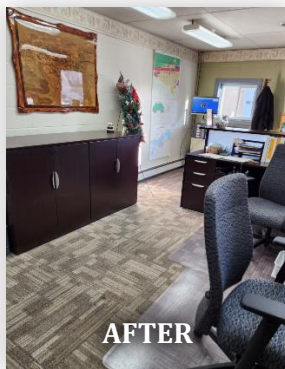

OAKES

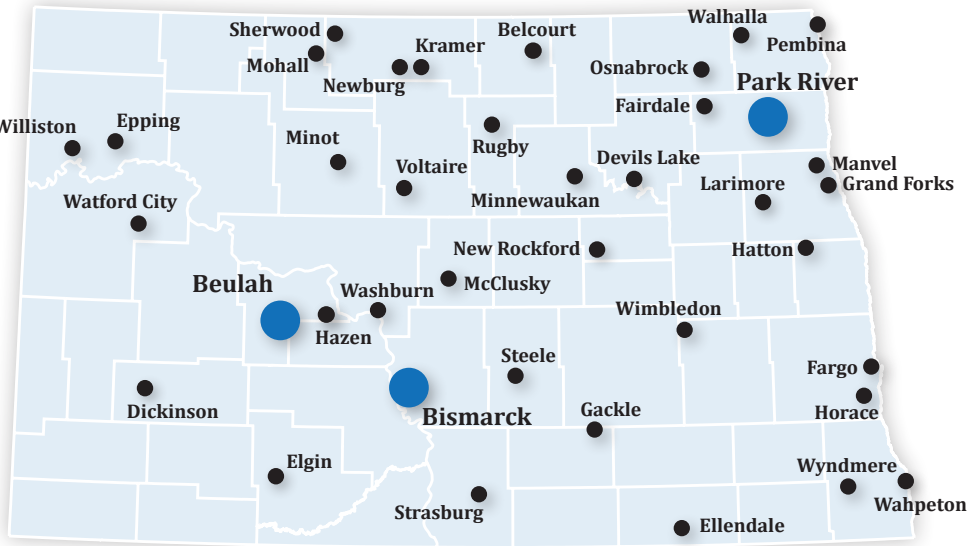
The North American Railcar Operators Association (NARCOA) is a nonprofit organization dedicated to the preservation, restoration and safe, legal operation of railroad equipment historically used for maintenance of way purposes. NARCOA members toured the Red River Valley and Western Railroad (RRVW) in the spring and made a special stop and demonstration of their railcars in Oakes. While there, NARCOA also made a \$1,000 donation to the Oakes Area Community Foundation.

Statewide Greatest Needs Fund

NDCF’s Statewide Greatest Needs Fund (SWGN) provides grant dollars for projects and programs across the state that make a significant difference in the quality of life of area residents. NDCF’s Board of Directors reviews grant applications once a year and determines grant awards. NDCF was pleased to award \$227,330 in grants in 2025 to 61 organizations across the state, for statewide programs as well as projects in communities shown here.



Bismarck: The Bismarck Adult Learning Center used their grant to purchase student bus passes for their students. *“Access to reliable transportation is one of the most critical barriers adult learners in our community face,”* wrote Ashley Coles in their application. *“We serve individuals working to earn their GED, improve English proficiency, and gain the skills needed for sustainable employment. Many of our learners are low-income, new Americans, or justice-involved individuals who do not have access to a personal vehicle.”*



Park River: *“Thank you for providing funds that helped our school district complete an early learning center project with a handicap accessible, preschool-aged playground for our community. This project was a missing piece in our community and it will have a positive, lasting impact on our children for generations to come.”* – Aaron Schram, Park River School District



NDCF received this grant report from the Bowman Regional Public Library in 2025. Their 2024 Statewide Greatest Needs Grant helped create a Green Space Backyard outside the library.

“The BRPL Backyard turned a humble gravel drainage ditch into a vibrant Green Space. What once was a haven for noxious weeds and parked cars is a beautiful pocket park. The space also gives the BRPL a place to engage the community with outdoor fun activities, messy “crafternoon” crafts, and relaxed events. We are delighted at the results of this project. We couldn’t have accomplished it without a knowledgeable landscaping company, the bold vision of the Bowman County Commission, and the organizations and individuals like the NDCF who bought into the vision that a space like this could be! Beulah: Coal Country Community Health Center has a new vitals cart, thanks to a SWGN grant. *“With a population of roughly 3000, not including the neighboring areas, the Beulah Clinic serves many individuals and families,”* wrote Dustin Joiner in their application. *“While every piece of equipment and every person working within the organization is important, a vitals cart is the established front-line workhorse of the organization. It is often the first step on virtually every medical journey which hopefully leads everyone safely home.”*

Otto Bremer Trust Community Responsive Fund

NDCF was honored to be chosen as the Otto Bremer Trust's (OBT) Intermediary Partner in North Dakota to distribute \$1 million in grants through their OBT Community Responsive Fund. NDCF administered grants directly to organizations within North Dakota that provided services in OBT's six areas of focus for 2025: mental health, capital projects for hospitals or clinics, children's health, children's disability services, literacy, and adoption and foster care services.

The OBT Community Responsive Fund provided significant grants (up to \$75,000 each) to 20 different organizations across the state, including the ones highlighted here. Minot: Dakota Girls and Boys Ranch opened Zurcher Cottage, a new Psychiatric Residential Facility that can house up to 16 children between 10 and 14 years of age that are survivors of significant trauma. ***"For some of our kids, this is the first time they've slept in a bed, not gone to bed hungry, or had anyone listen to their deepest pains and fears,"*** wrote Erinn Dosch in their grant application. ***"At the Ranch, we give them a safe place to live, learn, and heal so they can see the world differently and look to the future with hope."***

Jamestown: The Anne Carlsen Center has been a trusted provider of high-quality care for North Dakotans living with disabilities for more than 80 years. They serve individuals from birth through early adulthood through a wide range of in-home, outpatient, school-based, and residential programs. The OBT Community Responsive Fund grant supported ongoing programming including Residential Habilitation Services, outpatient therapy and mental health services in Jamestown, Fargo, Bismarck, Minot, and Grand Forks, and telehealth-based therapy and education to reach isolated areas and families with limited transportation access. *Photo from the Anne Carlsen Center Facebook page.*



Fargo: An OBT CRF grant bought automated medication cabinets and refrigeration for Heather's House, North Dakota's first Medicare-certified, free-standing hospice house that opened in the fall of 2025. The residential hospice care facility features 18 individual rooms and a host of home-like amenities to make patients and their families as comfortable as possible. *Photo from the HIA Hospice Facebook page.*



Harvey: St. Aloisius Medical Center in Harvey serves the rural population of Wells County and surrounding counties including McHenry, Pierce, Benson, Kidder, Eddy, Foster, and Sheridan counties. The OBT CRF grant helped purchase and install a new endoscopy processing system. The organization performed over 200 endoscopic procedures in 2024 and the new equipment will allow that number to increase.

Types of Funds

NDCF manages more than 1,000 funds for the betterment of North Dakota citizens and their communities. Below is more information about the various types of funds we manage with examples of each. If you are interested in establishing a new fund, give our staff a call and we can help you figure out the best type of fund to accomplish your charitable-giving goals.

COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS

Community foundations are permanent, flexible, financial resources for their communities and surrounding area. The grant money they provide to local projects and programs every year can make a huge difference in the quality of life for their residents. Over time, their endowment funds can become a substantial source of funding for their communities. Some communities also establish non-endowment funds for special projects in their area. NDCF manages 72 local community endowment funds in North Dakota and many have related project funds. New community funds at NDCF in 2025 include:



- Billings County Community Foundation Endowment Fund
- Gary A. Kelsch Estate – Mott-Regent Endowment

SCHOOL FUNDS

Numerous school foundations have been established in the last several years to provide additional resources to cash-strapped school districts. The additional funding from our school foundations fill in the gaps, providing everything from supplies to playground equipment to musical instruments to teacher housing. They can also provide long-term stability and resources for the school. In addition, several schools have established project funds at NDCF to supplement their capital projects if bids come in over estimates. NDCF welcomed the following school funds in 2025:

DONOR-ADVISED FUNDS

Many families choose to establish a donor-advised fund (DAF) at NDCF and recommend where their grant dollars should go every year. A DAF provides great flexibility and amazing tax benefits. It is also known as a simpler version of a Family Foundation without the detailed legal documents or annual audit and accounting paperwork required. NDCF provides access to online statements 24/7 and donors can clarify successor fund advisors if they would like their children or grandchildren to recommend grants from the fund in the future. There were 14 new DAFs started at NDCF in 2025.

SCHOLARSHIPS

With the rising costs of higher education, more and more college-bound students need a helping hand. Donors can determine whether they want to establish a permanent or temporary scholarship fund, if it's tied to a certain high school or college major, and general guidance about selection criteria. ORGANIZATION FUNDS

FISCAL SPONSORSHIPS

NDCF often serves as a fiscal sponsor for organizations, especially new causes just starting out. This allows people to focus on their passion instead of worrying about establishing 501(c)(3) status, tax implications, or other legal and administrative issues. NDCF served as the fiscal sponsor for the following funds created in 2025:

- RockLake Rural Fire Department Fund
- Southern Prairie Activity & Recreation Center for Wellness (SPARC)
- Dunn County Sheriff's Association Project Fund



The SPARC is a proposed community wellness center to be built in Wahpeton, North Dakota, and could include amenities such as a year-round indoor pool, courts for basketball, volleyball, and youth leagues, and dedicated activities for seniors to stay active and connected.

SPECIAL PURPOSE (RESTRICTED) FUNDS

At the request of the State, NDCF established the North Dakota June 2025 Storm Relief Fund to accept donations and distribute grants to those impacted by the tornados and long-lived derecho that swept across the state. As is its custom, NDCF waived its administrative fees for this disaster-response fund.





GIFT ANNUITIES

Charitable Gift Annuities provide an income for life to the donor and a gift to the causes that are most important to them when they're gone. CGAs are becoming an increasingly popular charitable-giving tool. NDCF manages several CGAs for North Dakotans interested in this option.

OPERATING FUNDS

Gifts to NDCF's Development Fund (non-endowment) or Operating Endowment Fund help us provide services to communities all across the state as they work to improve the quality of life for area residents. 2025 Financial Reports

The auditors have issued an unqualified opinion dated April 6, 2026, on the financial statements presented on pages 22 & 23. Honoring the Legacy of Burton L. Gewalt 1915-2009



Born and raised in Breckenridge, Minnesota, Burt L. Gewalt lived a life marked by innovation, service, and artistic passion. He attended Macalester College and the University of Michigan, where he developed an interest in modernism that would shape his architectural career.

During World War II, he contributed to the war effort by working in Boeing's engineering department in Seattle, helping manufacture B-17 Flying Fortresses. After the war, he transitioned back to architecture before serving as director of the Montana State Parks Commission.

Gewalt's expertise flourished in the 1950s and 1960s. Joining the firm of Foss and Company in Fargo, North Dakota, and Moorhead, Minnesota—a leader in modernist design—he specialized in church architecture, designing 37 churches across the Midwest.

In 1960, he moved to Kalispell, Montana, where he oversaw projects in Glacier National Park. His notable designs include the Logan Pass Visitor Center (1962-1963), the St. Mary Visitor Center (1963-1964), and the Lake McDonald Lodge Coffee Shop (1964-1965), all of which have been listed on the National Register of Historic Places for their modernist integration with natural landscapes.

Beyond architecture, Gewalt's life was rich with diverse pursuits. He earned his private pilot's license and seaplane rating, reflecting his lifelong love of aviation in many of his over 500 watercolor paintings. A Mason for more than 50 years, he remained active in flying until 2006.

In 1969, he relocated to Yachats, Oregon, where he designed and built his own home. He married Patricia Parker in 1983, and together they shared 25 years until his passing at age 93.

The Burton Louis Gewalt Meritorious Scholarship Fund was created with a gift from Burton's estate in 2009 and awarded scholarships to graduating seniors from Breckenridge High School for many years. After the passing of Burt's wife in 2025, the remainder of his trust (approximately \$3.4 million) was deposited in the scholarship fund, substantially increasing scholarship awards for future generations of Breckenridge students forever.



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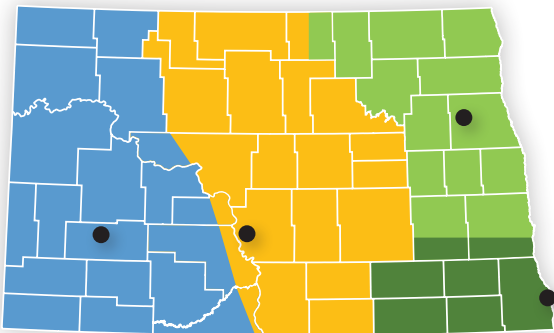
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
