#### **Our Mission**

Established in 2014 by a group of residents, the Williston Area Community Foundation is a permanent endowment fund that can support our community for years to come. Earnings from the fund are given as grants to support nonprofit projects or programs in the area that work to improve our community and quality of life.

#### **Our Committee**

A group of local volunteers serves as an Advisory Committee to the Foundation and has two main purposes: first, to spread the vision and purpose of the foundation by building partnerships with community projects and area leadership. Also, to grant earnings of the fund back into the community to those projects improving the quality of life for area residents.

#### **Our Service**

We partner with the George & Helen Christensen Family Charitable Fund and together these funds have helped fund numerous key initiatives in our community. Grantees include:

- Williams County Social Services: school supplies for foster care youth
- Acro Star Gymnastics: building expansion project
- Dakota Children's Advocacy Center: child abuse outreach services in Western ND
- Injured Military Wildlife Project of ND
- BIO Girls: funding to start a BIO Girls program in Williston
