\$6,150 Awarded in 2023

The Hebron Area Community Foundation awarded \$6,150 in four different grants in May of this year:

- **Hebron Park District:** \$3,000 for pool maintenance and upkeep
- **Hebron Public School:** \$1,700 to bring the Missoula Children's Theatre to town for a week-long residency.
- Hebron Ambulance Service: \$1,025 for XPS restraints
- Missouri Slope Areawide United Way: \$425 for the Dolly Parton Imagination Library

"Their team (Missoula Children's Theatre) of two professional actor/directors will arrive in our community with a set, lights, costumes, props and make-up... everything it takes to put on a play - except, the cast," wrote Elizabeth Wanner in the school's grant application. "This weeklong residency begins with an open group audition and culminates in two public performances. Fifty to sixty students grades K-12 are cast and well-rehearsed throughout the week, learning lines, songs, and choreography to perform in a full-length musical."

Grants are awarded once a year. Any organization with a 501(c)(3) status or government agency may apply. Applications are available online beginning March 1 at www.NDCF.net/Hebron. ◊


