The mission of the North Dakota Community Foundation is to improve the quality of life for North Dakota’s citizens through charitable giving and promoting philanthropy.

About the North Dakota Community Foundation

The North Dakota Community Foundation was incorporated in 1976. NDCF is an IRS designated 501(c)(3) statewide, public, nonprofit, tax-exempt corporation that receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.

NDCF was formed by a group of concerned citizens who were looking for a general purpose charitable vehicle to build endowment to support important needs for communities and projects all across the state. Initial support for the Foundation came from the Otto Bremer Foundation (now the Otto Bremer Trust), the Northwest Area Foundation, the Norwest Bancorporation, the North Dakota Bremer Banks and the Bush Foundation.

NDCF has continued to grow and flourish over the years thanks to the support of thousands of individuals and businesses who want to make North Dakota a better place to live, work, and play.

National Standards

The National Standards Seal represents official confirmation from the Community Foundations National Standards Board that NDCF has met the most rigorous standards for community foundations. The seal affirms NDCF’s commitment to financial security, transparency, and accountability and says that our grantmaking includes an open, competitive process designed to address the changing needs of our community.

Chair & CEO Letter

2024 was a good year for the Foundation. In fact, it was the best year in terms of gifts received and grants made since the Foundation’s incorporation in 1976 (except for the year 1997 when NDCF handled most of the private money for the flood response and recovery for the Red River Valley flood). The pages of this report contain, as they do every year, lists. Many, many lists of donors, organizations, amounts of gifts and grants, and even a few stories selected to “report” on the work of the North Dakota Community Foundation and its component funds for just one year.

Just who is supporting the North Dakota Community Foundation and its work all across North Dakota? As you may suspect, most of the donors to the Foundation are North Dakotans - some of whom live here, and some of whom live elsewhere, but their heart still lives here. That’s the thing about North Dakota - those who grew up here often hold this state and its people close to their hearts. They often express that love through a gift to their hometown community foundation, to the school foundation which supports the school that they attended, to a memorial scholarship fund in memory of a departed loved one. The common denominator is the North Dakota Community Foundation. The Foundation has the honor and the privilege of helping those who love this state by providing an efficient and effective structure through which to accomplish their charitable dreams and to express their love for North Dakota.

Examples include:

- Yvonne Ranschler was born and raised near Hazelton, ND. She spent most of her adult life in California, but her heart never left her hometown. Not only did she give to help get the Hazelton Area Community Foundation started, she made the Hazelton Fund a beneficiary of her IRA and her Annuity. Her legacy gifts more than tripled the size of the Hazelton Fund which will soon have more than \$10,000 to give annually for projects in the community that she loved and which her heart never left.
- Dr. Roger Meisner didn’t grow up in North Dakota, but he attended Veterinary Medical School with many North Dakotans and later practiced for a time in North Dakota. He no longer lived in North Dakota but remembered his ND classmates who helped him achieve his Vet Med degree. He established the NDCF Veterinary Medicine Scholarship Fund (originally named the Dr. Roger E. Meisner Veterinary Medicine Scholarship Fund) in the 1990s and added to it over the years. He also included the Fund in his estate plan. Dr. Meisner passed away in the fall of 2023. With the gift from his estate, his scholarship fund now has assets of over \$6 million. This means that Dr. Meisner’s love for North Dakota will be expressed by helping ND Vet Med students to the tune of \$240,000 annually going forward.
- The family whose 90+ year-old matriarch had several thousand bushels of harvested crops in their grain bins that, if sold, would have triggered substantial tax obligations. The crops were gifted to the North Dakota Community Foundation for a donor-advised fund. The family can now recommend grants from the Fund to their home area. They avoided the increase in taxes and are able to recommend over \$2 million in grants to support their local community foundation’s endowment and to support immediate needs of the community.

These are but three examples of how the North Dakota Community Foundation has helped people with North Dakota in their hearts make a difference here, where their heart still lives. If you are reading this report, you are one of those with the love of North Dakota in your heart. 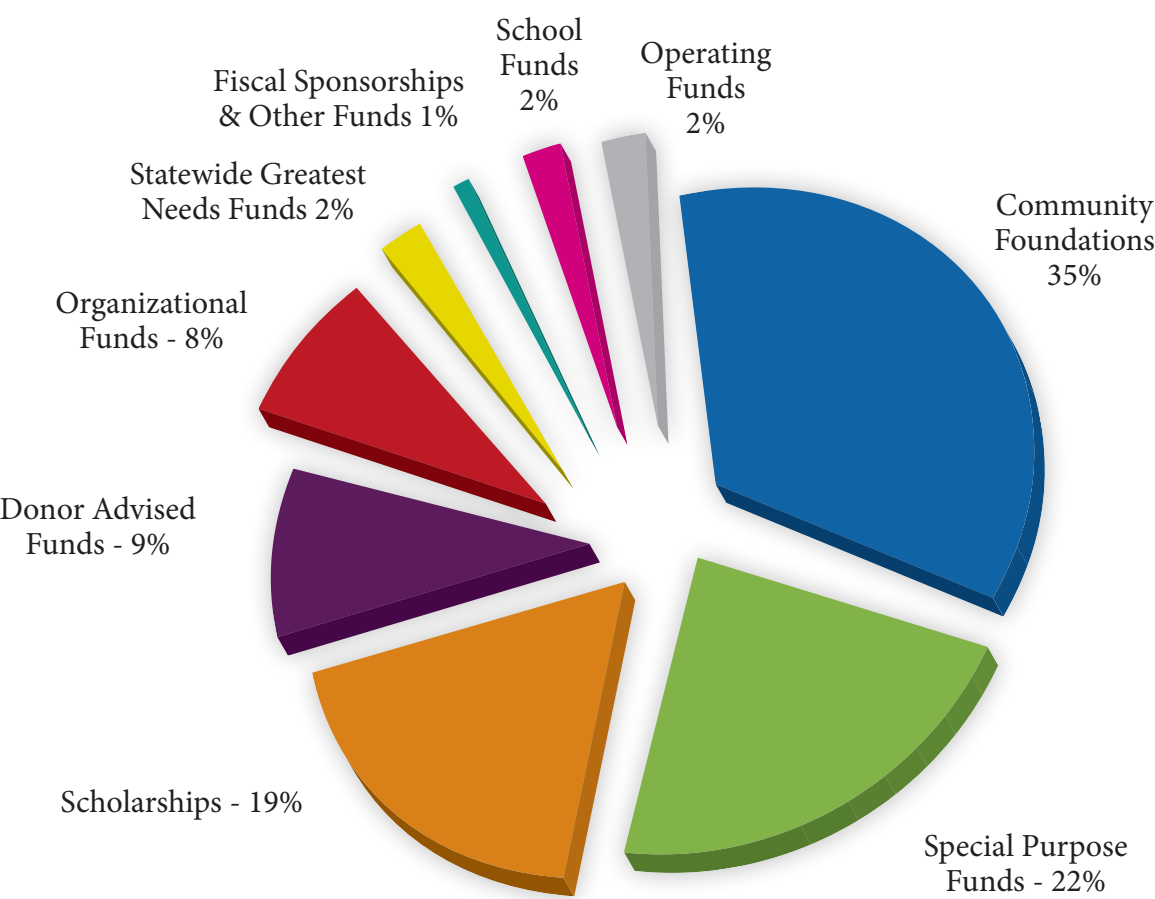

Here are some highlights from 2024!

Kevin Dvorak and John Heinen staffed a booth at the Williston Basin Petroleum Conference to share the good work we do in communities all across the state, including in the Bakken. Our staff were also at the North Dakota Association of NonProfit Organizations annual conference where Kevin led a breakout session about the power of endowment and various charitable giving options.



NDCF was honored to be chosen as a philanthropic partner of the Otto Bremer Trust and distributed \$1.5 million in grants in North Dakota from OBT's Community Responsive Fund. Representatives from OBT, including two of the three trustees, visited Bismarck in September to review the process. While here, they learned more about and toured the facilities of two grant recipients – Hope Manor and The Dream Center (pictured).

When wildfires broke out in western North Dakota on a windy weekend in early October, the State contacted NDCF to establish a disaster response fund. 2,751 gifts, totaling more than \$18.7 million to NDCF funds in 2024!

More than \$770,000 awarded in scholarships to North Dakota youth and 10 NEW scholarship funds started in 2024.

45 new funds started at NDCF in 2024 to improve the quality of life in our state, including the Rolette Foundation for Education.



More than \$12.5 million in grants and charitable disbursements for projects and programs all across the state, including a grant from the Parshall Area Community Foundation to the Parshall Promoters. This grant helped the group fund four large signs placed on Highways 37 and 23 directing travelers to the community.

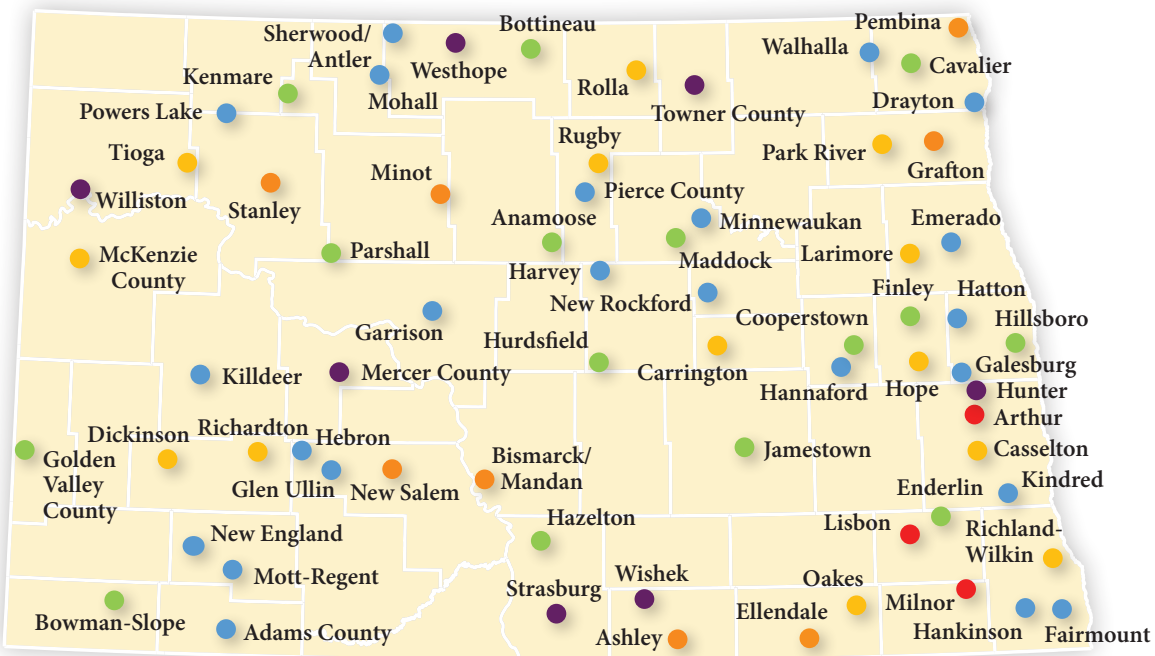

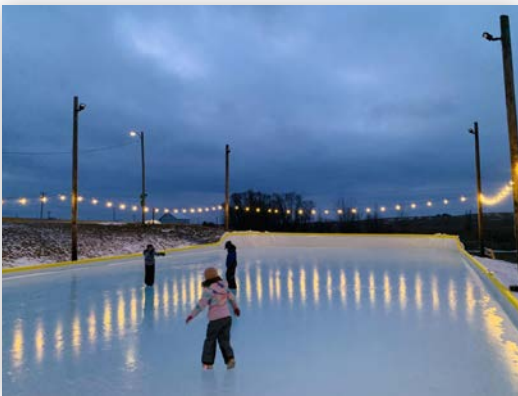
Our Community Foundations

Our local community foundations are the signature program of the North Dakota Community Foundation. NDCF currently manages local community funds for 69 different communities, counties, or areas in the state. These funds each have an advisory committee made up of local residents that lead fundraising efforts and recommend grant awards. These grants fund projects and programs that greatly improve the quality of life in these communities. It's an excellent example of local residents investing their charitable dollars in their own hometown, supporting their own nonprofit organizations and needs. Here are some highlights from 2024:



GRAFTON

The Grafton Community Foundation SuperGrant helped fund the creation of Harmony Garden, an accessible musical installation at Leistikow Park. The project featured 15 interactive musical instruments, along with three benches, trees, flowers, boulders, mulch, a stamped sidewalk, and signage. The Harmony Garden was designed to offer a free, inclusive activity for the Grafton community, benefiting individuals of all ages, abilities, and backgrounds, particularly children, seniors, and people with developmental disabilities.



NEW SALEM

A grant from the New Salem Area Community Foundation funded landscaping, electrical work, and ice rink components for the new community ice rink at W.H. Mann Pioneer Park. A volleyball court was added to provide additional use of the area during the summer months, making the location a year-round attraction for the community. *“This project changed the park from just a grass filled green space to a destination!”* noted Chad Goetzfridt, New Salem City Council member. *“Parents with young children, older children, high school age kids, and adults have all been at the ice rink.”*



BISMARCK/MANDAN

The BisMan Community Foundation awarded three Community Impact Awards in 2024, recognizing the amazing volunteers who give back to their community. Pictured here are members of the BisMan Community Foundation Advisory Committee with Dale Pahlke, who was honored with the Community Commitment Award.

RICHLAND-WILKIN

The Richland Wilkin Community Foundation hosted a Power of 100 event in September and awarded three grants to area nonprofits, including one to the Children's Discovery Center.

Statewide Greatest Needs Fund

NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund provides grant dollars for projects and programs across the state that make a significant difference in the quality of life of area residents. NDCF's Board of Directors reviews grant applications once a year and determines grant awards. NDCF was pleased to award \$223,223 in grants in 2024 to 51 organizations across the state, for statewide programs as well as projects in communities shown here.



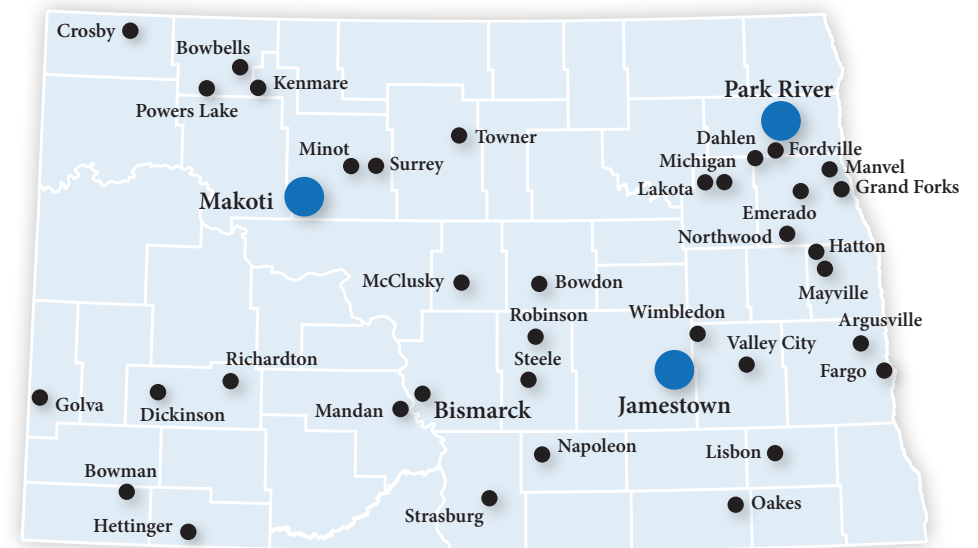
Jamestown: The Jamestown Fine Arts Association is expanding into an adjacent building in order to provide more space and more programming, specifically for their Arts After School program. *“Our goal with this project is to increase our services across the board, but our primary focus is to provide more arts programming for the children in our community,”* explained Riley Akevik in their application. *“With the expansion planned, we are expecting to house nearly 60 students in our Arts After School program, almost quadrupling our numbers! Over the next year, we intend on redesigning the space into a “kid-centric” space to enhance the arts education of all children in our community.”*



NDCF received this thank you from the Central Dakota Forensic Nurse Examiners in 2024. They used their 2023 Statewide Greatest Needs Grant to develop and print educational materials and stickers related to teen dating violence prevention and healthy relationships. These were distributed with self-care products (lotion, lip balm, soap) in 500 colorful backpacks and distributed throughout their service area with the help of 14 partner organizations including Youthworks, public health units, Sacred Pipe Resource Center, and Children's Advocacy Centers.

“We are incredibly grateful to NDCF for allowing us to do this work. We knew there was a need, but after launching this program we quickly realized the need was much greater than originally known. This education program is becoming a pillar of our prevention work and has expanded to adults. The requests for materials and presentations since launching the program have grown every month and now include partnerships with Heartview Foundation and Home On The Range. This work is possible because of you!”

Thank you to those who have donated to our Statewide Greatest Needs Fund and make grants like this possible!



Makoti: The Community Food Pantry in Makoti serves approximately 85-120 people monthly in this very rural area of our state. A grant from our Statewide Greatest Needs Fund will replace the broken water pipes and wood railing for their front steps. *“We are counted on by the needy and homeless in this area and supply food for the rural school backpack program,”* wrote Kathleen Kimball in their grant application.

Park River: The Park River Community Theatre Association will use their \$5,000 grant to help repair the leaky roof of this historic building, originally constructed in 1915. *“The Lyric Theatre is one of only two movie theatres in Walsh County, which spans 1,294 square miles and is home to a little over 10,000 residents,”* wrote Josh Anderson in their grant application. *“The theatre regularly seats people across generations, including young children, parents, and grandparents, and the Association continues to find ways to draw teens and young adults to the local theatre.”*

Types of Funds

NDCF manages over 950 funds for the betterment of North Dakota citizens and their communities. Below is more information about the various types of funds we manage with examples of each. If you are interested in establishing a new fund or adding to an existing fund, give our staff a call and we can help you figure out the best type of fund to accomplish your charitable-giving goals.

COMMUNITY FOUNDATIONS

Community foundations are permanent, flexible, financial resources for their communities and surrounding area. The grant money they provide to local projects and programs every year can make a huge difference in the quality of life for their residents. Over time, their endowment funds can become a substantial source of funding for their communities. Some communities also establish non-endowment funds for special projects in their area. NDCF manages 69 local community foundations in North Dakota and many have related project funds.



- NDCF welcomed the Ascension Lutheran Church Charitable Fund in 2024, which will support projects and programs in Emerado, North Dakota. When the church closed its doors after years of dwindling membership, the congregation decided to use the proceeds from the sale of the building and its furnishings to make gifts to area organizations, including a \$50,000 gift to support the Emerado community through this named fund.

SCHOOL FUNDS

Numerous school foundations have been established in the last several years to provide additional resources to cash-strapped school districts. The additional funding from our school foundations fill in the gaps, providing everything from supplies to playground equipment to musical instruments to teacher housing. They can also provide long-term stability and resources for the school. In addition, several schools have established project funds at NDCF to supplement their capital projects if bids come in over estimates. NDCF welcomed the following school funds in 2024:

The mission of the Bakken Area Skills Center is to empower individuals through career and technical education, fostering a skilled workforce that meets the evolving needs of the region. Their foundation at NDCF provides a mechanism for local residents, corporations, alum and others to provide financial resources to enhance education and opportunities for all CTE students taking classes.



SCHOLARSHIPS

With the rising costs of higher education, more and more college-bound students need a helping hand. Donors can determine whether they want to establish a permanent or temporary scholarship fund, if it's tied to a certain high school or college major, and general guidance about selection criteria. ORGANIZATION FUNDS

Endowment funds provide long-term financial resources for organizations and can be an integral part of how they fund their operations and special projects every year. The stability of an endowment fund means the organization's mission can continue for countless generations. In addition, some organizations establish non-endowment funds at NDCF to help raise money for particular projects. Welcome to the following new organization funds:

The Freeman Foundation utilized its fund at NDCF to award six grants across the state in 2024 that addressed food security. NDCF staff members Amy Stromsodt and Robin Salander delivered a \$25,000 grant to Marcia Paulson of the Great Plains Food Bank in June of 2024.

FISCAL SPONSORSHIPS

NDCF often serves as a fiscal sponsor for organizations, especially new causes just starting out. This allows people to focus on their passion instead of worrying about establishing 501(c)(3) status, tax implications, or other legal and administrative issues. NDCF served as the fiscal sponsor for following funds created in 2024:

- Bearcat Den Daycare, Inc.
- Beyond Housing, Inc.



Beyond Housing is located in Valley City, ND.

NDCF manages several endowed cemetery funds. Annual grants from these funds help with the ongoing maintenance and upkeep of cemeteries all across the state. Both the St. John Cemetery and Calvin Corinthian Cemetery (pictured) established endowed funds at NDCF in 2024.



SPECIAL PURPOSE (RESTRICTED) FUNDS

Some funds are established at NDCF with a specific cause in mind. These special purpose or “restricted” funds can be related to a one-time disaster response or support specific charities and projects permanently. New special purpose funds established at NDCF in 2024 include:

COMMITTEE RECOMMENDED FUNDS

When a group of donors wishes to recommend the grant awards every year from their charitable fund, they can establish a Committee-Recommended Fund at NDCF.

DONOR-ADVISED FUNDS

Many choose to establish a donor-advised fund (DAF) at NDCF and recommend where their grant dollars should go every year. A DAF provides great flexibility and amazing tax benefits. It is also known as a simpler version of a Family Foundation or private foundation without the detailed legal documents or annual audit and accounting paperwork required. NDCF provides access to online statements 24/7 and donors can clarify successor fund advisors if they would like their children or grandchildren to recommend grants from the fund in the future. There were 8 new DAFs started at NDCF in 2024.

GIFT ANNUITIES

Charitable Gift Annuities provide an income for life to the donor and a gift to the causes that are most important to them when they’re gone. CGAs are becoming an increasingly popular charitable-giving tool. NDCF manages several CGAs for North Dakotans interested in this option.

OPERATING FUNDS

Gifts to NDCF’s Development Fund (non-endowment) or Operating Endowment Fund help us provide services to communities all across the state as they work to improve the quality of life for area residents. Thank you to those donors and organizations who choose to provide direct support to our organization!



2024 Financial Reports

Should your gift last forever?

You can endow your gift so that a portion of earnings is spent and the gift remains a permanent resource for the projects and programs you wish to support. Gifts to a qualified North Dakota endowment fund are eligible for a 40% state tax credit in addition to the Federal charitable income tax deduction. 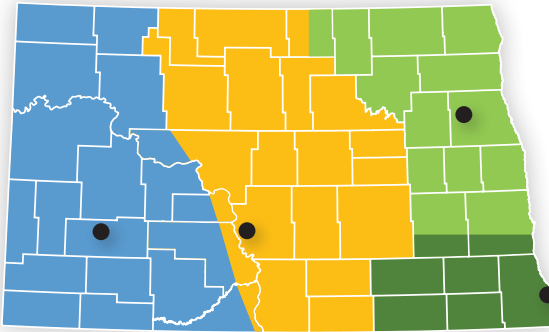

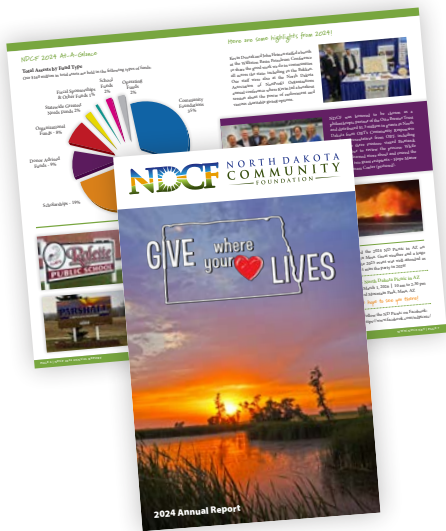
