The mission of the North Dakota Community Foundation is to improve the quality of life for North Dakota’s citizens through charitable giving and promoting philanthropy.

About the North Dakota Community Foundation

The North Dakota Community Foundation was incorporated in 1976. NDCF is an IRS designated 501(c)(3) statewide, public, nonprofit, tax-exempt corporation that receives and distributes charitable funds to support a wide range of programs that benefit North Dakotans.

NDCF was formed by a group of concerned citizens who were looking for a general charitable vehicle to build endowment to support the nonprofit sector in the state. Initial support for the Foundation came from the Otto Bremer Foundation (now the Otto Bremer Trust), the Northwest Area Foundation, the Norwest Bancorporation, the North Dakota Bremer Banks and the Bush Foundation.

NDCF has continued to grow and flourish over the years thanks to the support of thousands of individuals and businesses who want to make North Dakota a better place to live, work, and play.

National Standards

The National Standards Seal represents official confirmation from the Community Foundations National Standards Board that NDCF has met the most rigorous standards for community foundations. The seal affirms NDCF’s commitment to financial security, transparency, and accountability and says that our grantmaking includes an open, competitive process designed to address the changing needs of our community.

Chair & CEO Letter

2022 Annual Report

The North Dakota Community Foundation's core business is the building of permanent endowment funds for communities and organizations in our state. These permanent charitable assets enable NDCF and our grantees to continue to do our work in good times and bad. You can see the details of that good work on the pages that follow, which list our 2022 grants by fund.

In addition to these permanent funds, however, we are often asked to provide other services that benefit those who live in our state. We are happy to assist in those endeavors as well. Some recent examples of our non-endowed work include:

- When the City of Dickinson wanted to create a town square to vitalize their downtown with a gathering space to bring people together, they needed a financial structure to raise private monies to accomplish their goal. By using the North Dakota Community Foundation to be the recipient of private gifts, donors can assist in defraying the expenses related to the project and receive a charitable deduction for doing so.
- Several school districts around the state have recently passed bond issues, but because of inflation and other factors do not have enough resources in the bond issue to fully finish out the project. Private donors interested in assisting with the school project can give to the fund set up at the NDCF, receive a tax deduction to enhance and finish out the building project. We have been honored to serve the school districts of Alexander, Kulm, New Rockford-Sheyenne, Stanley, and others in this capacity to see their projects to fruition.
- When a group of energy companies doing business in North Dakota wanted to help the ND Tribal colleges with apprenticeship programs, they asked the North Dakota Community Foundation to administer the multi-million dollar, multi-year grant.

When we are asked to assist in projects around the state or when people donate to one of our existing endowment funds, it is a testament to the trust that people place in the North Dakota Community Foundation to be good stewards of their gifts and to carry out their charitable intent efficiently and effectively. The names of our donors appear in the back part of this report. Look that list over carefully. You will, no doubt, recognize many of those names. The names of people of modest means and some with more than modest means. Through the North Dakota Community Foundation, they all make a difference in their community and for the cause that touches their hearts and minds. We are honored to help them and to help you to accomplish your charitable goals.

In these and many other ways, the North Dakota Community Foundation seeks and finds ways to be useful to all the citizens of North Dakota. Our mission is: "to improve the quality of life for North Dakota's citizens through charitable giving and promoting philanthropy." That is a very broad statement, we have very broad and diverse programs and projects to help to accomplish that mission. The Foundation Center published a book years ago entitled "An Agile Servant". It is a book about the many ways that a community foundation can make a difference in the community that they serve. Through our many and diverse programs, we strive to be an agile servant for the people of North Dakota.



NDCF 2022 At-A-Glance

Total Assets by Fund Type

Our \$113 million in total assets are held in the following types of funds:



3,750 gifts, totaling over \$11.8 million to NDCF funds in 2022!

\$692,000 awarded in scholarships to North Dakota youth and 8 NEW scholarship funds started in 2022.



52 New Funds started at NDCF in 2022 to improve the quality of life in our state, including the Save The Maah Daah Hey Trail Endowment Fund.

Over \$8.2 million in grants and charitable disbursements for projects and programs all across the state, including a grant from the Dickinson Rotary Club's Charitable Fund to encourage and enable girls to join the new Girls Wrestling Program at Dickinson. The money helped pay for scholarships to attend summer wrestling camp and singlets (uniforms) for the team. There were 18 girls in the program in the fall of 2022.

WELCOME

We welcomed our new accountant Jeff Wanek in March!



NDCF was proud to support the ND Association of Nonprofit Organization's annual conference in June in Minot. Kara Geiger staffed our booth, sharing information about NDCF and our organizational endowment funds with attendees. The nonprofit sector in North Dakota strengthens the economy, improves our communities, and provides over 54,000 jobs in the state!

NDCF was honored to be asked to administer the new ND Tribal College System Apprenticeship program, announced by Governor Burgum in September. Over the next four years, Hess Corporation will invest \$12 million to provide tuition assistance, stipends and other support for establishing apprenticeships in a variety of industries through the state's five tribal colleges. Halliburton and Nabors Industries will each invest an additional \$1 million. NDCF will work with the colleges in the distribution of the funds as they establish their programs.



Our Community Foundations

Our local community foundations are the signature program of the North Dakota Community Foundation. NDCF currently manages local community funds for 69 different communities, counties, or areas in the state. These funds each have an advisory committee made up of local residents that lead fundraising efforts and recommend grant awards. These grants fund projects and programs that greatly improve the quality of life in these communities. It's an excellent example of local residents keeping their charitable dollars in their own hometown, supporting their own nonprofit organizations and needs. Here are some happenings from 2022:



● \$5 Million +

● \$1,000,000 – \$4,999,999 in total assets

● \$500,000 – \$999,999 in total assets

● \$250,000 – \$499,999 in total assets

● \$100,000 – \$249,999 in total assets

● 0 – \$99,999 in total assets

● **Total assets in our Community Endowment Fund Program is over \$42 million!**

● We received **1,867 donations** to our community funds in 2022, totaling over **\$1.5 million.**

● **382 grants** were awarded in 2022 from our Community Endowment Funds, totaling almost **\$1.7 million!**



MOTT-REGENT

The meat cooler at the Regent Consumer Co-op was beyond repair - noisy, leaking water, and occasionally going out. A grant from the Mott-Regent Community Foundation helped replace it, so that area residents have a convenient source for fresh meat.

ELLENDALE

The Ellendale Area Community Foundation provided a grant to the Ellendale Area Arts Council for their “Concert in the Park” series during the summer. Five concerts were presented and total attendance was around 300. “The Ellendale community was able to experience live music that is typically not provided in a small town such as Ellendale. Not only were these concerts provided to the community at no charge to those that attended the concerts in the South Park but each artist played additional concerts at the Evergreen assisted living facility and at the Benedict nursing home. Without the EACF funding these concerts would not be able to happen.” – Justin Meidinger, Ellendale Area Arts Council.



COOPERSTOWN

Grants for our community foundations also address workforce needs in our state. Griggs County Central School in Cooperstown did a complete re-shaping of the school-to-work program that prepares students for hard-to-fill jobs available in Cooperstown. Welding and manufacturing were identified as key hands-on jobs in the local area that needed skilled employees. A grant from the Cooperstown Community Foundation helped purchase the necessary equipment and supplies to re-start the welding program, which has 12 students in it for the 2022-2023 school year. The district has been in contact with two specific business in Cooperstown and the local area about their need for welders immediately, along with many farmers wanting that skill for their employees.




BOTTINEAU, SHERWOOD-ANTLER, AND MOHALL

Frank Larson, founder of Starion Bank, offered a matching grant to the community funds of Bottineau, Sherwood-Antler, and Mohall to help grow their assets. Fundraisers were held (like the “Look Who Survived the Winter” supper in Antler in the photo) and generous residents made donations to secure Frank’s matching gifts. Thank you to Frank and these community leaders for providing permanent charitable resources for their areas!

Statewide Greatest Needs Fund

NDCF's Statewide Greatest Needs Fund provides grant dollars for projects and programs across the state that make a significant difference in the quality of life of area residents. NDCF's Board of Directors reviews grant applications once a year and determines grant awards. NDCF was pleased to award \$212,200 in grants in 2022 to 50 organizations across the state, including those shown here.

Baldwin: Hope Reins received a grant to start a Horse-Powered Reading® program. *“Social-emotional issues, ADHD, anxiety, depression, and other mental health concerns often get in the way of student learning. Horse Powered Reading® can break through those challenges giving students a chance to learn or reinforce reading and other academic skills in the moment. This groundbreaking program incorporates researched based reading strategies and the incredible power and presence of horses.”* - Dr. Sara Kenney for Hope Reins in their grant application.



THANK YOU!

NDCF received this thank you from the City of Pekin in 2022. They added a shelter and port-a-potty at their city park with a 2021 SWGN grant from NDCF.

“The contractor who built the shelter invited community members to help build the shelter, this brought many people together, which in a small town is great to see. The new port-a-potty at the park was a much needed improvement. We had no idea how much it would be used until this summer. A huge THANK YOU!!! Coming from a very small town, with less than 100 people and no real businesses in the town, it is so hard to find help, sponsorship or donations for projects to improve our park. We have so many visitors who utilize our park, but keeping it maintained and up to date requires help and the help of grants like the NDCF greatest needs grant is such a blessing for us in small towns.” - Sarah Haugland, Pekin Park Board.

The organization is run completely by volunteers and parents. A SWGN grant helped them with an expansion project so they can increase membership and classes.

Grand Forks: NDCF awarded SWGN grants to 14 different food pantries in 2022, including the Northlands Rescue Mission in Grand Forks. All have seen a tremendous increase in the number of requests for assistance in recent years, mostly due to the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic.

Bowman: The Pioneer Trails Regional Museum will be using their 2022 SWGN grant to improve the paleontology exhibit with current research and interactive displays for all ages to enjoy. *“Interactive exhibits are a particular draw in museum settings. This allows visitors to connect to the information at a different level. It is one thing to read about a concept and another to experience it. Hands-on activity will drive engagement in the museum and bring families coming back to the museum over and over. We also would like to bring awareness to the animals that lived in this area after the dinosaurs went extinct. This time period reflects animals that lived around 32 million years ago and includes ancient horses, rhinos, and camels. With so much focus on the dinosaurs in the region, these animals are often overlooked, but are an important part of our history.”* Jean Nudell for the Pioneer Trails Regional Museum.



Donor Honors Parents

– with Gifts to Their Community –

Bill Knudson has fond memories of growing up in Richardton, North Dakota, the middle child of five. Knudson and his family moved to the community when he was four years old. His father became the manager of Farmers State Bank, which was a Bremer Bank, and also worked as an appraiser.

“Working for Bremer was a good fit for my dad,” said Knudson. “Bremer Banks are owned by a non-profit and give back to their communities and my dad was also philanthropic.”

Knudson’s parents, Darrell “D.W.” and Lorine Knudson, met in Dickinson. D.W. served in the Army during World War II and Lorine was a riveter. They married in 1943 and lived in Fergus Falls, Minnesota, before moving to Richardton in 1955. They built a house in town shortly after moving there and lived the rest of their lives in Richardton, raising their children and supporting their community.

The town was vibrant in those years.

“There were two car dealerships, two grocery stores, a bowling alley, a dry goods store, and three bars,” Knudson remembers. “It was a thriving community – a good place to grow up. Seems like it was a less dangerous, more innocent time.”

Knudson’s older sisters attended St. Mary’s High School in Richardton as there was no public school there at the time (boys attended Assumption Abbey High School). Richardton Public School was built during this time and Knudson graduated from the new high school in 1969. He earned an Associate of Arts degree from Assumption College in Richardton, graduated from Creighton University with a degree in Economics and

Finance, and became an appraiser, like his father. Knudson worked with his father doing appraisals in Richardton for about eight years after college before starting his own appraisal firm in Bismarck.

Lorine passed away in 1998 and D.W. continued to live in the home they built in Richardton for another decade. He spent the last two years of his life at the Richardton Health Center, passing away in 2012.



Knudson recently made a donation of \$10,000 to the Richardton Area Community Foundation in honor of his parents and the legacy they left in Richardton.

“I’ve been aware of the foundation for awhile and wanted to do something to give back and to honor my parents,” he said. “Richardton was such an important part of their lives. It’s not about me . . . it’s about my parents and how hard they worked to build their community. It’s important to do that and to keep doing that. There are a lot of good community leaders who take pride in their town . . . that’s what “community” is.”

D.W. and Lorine’s legacy of building community will continue now forever, thanks to this gift from their son.

Giving Other Than Cash

The North Dakota Community Foundation can and has received many different types of gifts to benefit various funds under its umbrella. Depending on your situation, you may want to consider donating one of the following for their tax benefits or other reasons:

- **Real estate**, which allows the donor to deduct the current appraised value of the real estate and avoid capital gains taxes.
- **Fully depreciated business property** (farm equipment, etc.) You can’t take a tax deduction, but there is no tax due on the transfer and the value of the property qualifies for the ND 40% income tax credit if given to a qualified ND endowment fund.
- **Gifts of farm commodities**, which don’t give a tax deduction, however they don’t have to be counted as income. You can still deduct the cost of production for whatever you donate. These gifts also may qualify for the 40% ND income tax credit for gifts to qualified ND endowment funds. *(Note: you must donate the commodity first to get these tax advantages, not sell it and donate the proceeds later.)*
- **Appreciated investment assets**, valued on the date of transfer, are tax deductible and you can avoid paying capital gains tax. These gifts may also qualify for the ND income tax credit.
- **Charitable IRA rollover** counts as your required minimum distribution, but you don’t need to claim the donated portion as federal income and the gift may qualify for the 40% ND income tax credit.
- **Gifts of mineral acres outright**, assignment of mineral royalty income, or make the North Dakota Community Foundation an income or remainder beneficiary of your family mineral trust (Be sure to designate which fund or funds at NDCF should benefit from your generosity!)




