Grenora Public School is kicking off a Scoreboard Sponsorship Drive. This drive will help to offset the cost for the replacement of the main gym scoreboard, which had an irreparable mechanical failure in the computer system. The following is a breakdown of how different sponsorship amounts will be recognized; however, Grenora Public School will accept sponsorships of any size:

\$1000 and up: Name or company logo appears on the scoreboard advertisement section. Individuals would receive lifetime GPS event passes for themselves and immediate family members

\$500 to \$999: Name in 4 inch letters on a plaque* & Individual lifetime pass to all GPS events

\$250 to \$499: Name in 3 inch letters on a plaque* \$100 to \$249: Name in 2 inch letters on plaque* *plaques will be placed near the scoreboards
