## \$6,030 Awarded in 2025

The Hebron Area Community Foundation awarded \$6,030 in four different grants in 2025:

- **Hebron Public School:**
  - \$2,220 for Reading Rewards—providing books to reward and encourage reading
  - \$2,200 to bring in Missoula Children's Theatre for students to participate in a theatrical production
- **Bearcat Den Daycare Inc:** \$1,120 for a storage shed
- **Brick City Activity Center:** \$470 to refurbish exterior of building

Grants are awarded once a year. Applications are available online beginning March 1 at [www.NDCF.net/Hebron](http://www.NDCF.net/Hebron).





## Can YOU Help Us Fill The Gap?


Our committee receives many more grant requests every year than we have available dollars to grant.



In fact, we have received a total of **more than \$77,000 in grant requests** in the last three years, but have only had enough earnings to award \$18,000 in grants (see chart below). **That's only meeting 23% of the need in our community.**
