- Market Value of Fund (as of 11/30/25): **\$595,307**
- Total Gifts to the Fund in 2025 (as of 11/30/25): **\$1,110**
- Grants awarded in 2025: **10 grants totaling \$19,664**
- Total grants awarded since inception: **304 grants totaling \$362,067**

## \$19,664 Awarded in 2025

- Richardton Baseball Club:** \$7,500 for baseball/rodeo concession building with restrooms
- Richardton Healthcare Foundation:** \$3,764 to replace the Resident Vitals Cart
- Jacobson Memorial Hospital Care Center:** \$2,000 purchase EKG machine for the Richardton Clinic
- Taylor Community Activities Inc.:** \$1,500 for Heritage Hill Capital Improvement Project
- Richardton Senior Citizens Club Inc.:** \$1,400 for updates and maintenance to the facility
- American Legion Auxiliary Unit 180:** \$1,000 for carpet cleaning/sanitizing lights for walk-in cooler
- Camp Recreation Inc.:** \$1,000 to support their programs
- Lt. Theo R Zech American Legion Post #180:** \$500 for memorial flagpole repair
- Richardton-Taylor Public School Library:** \$500 for a campus library revitalization
- WayMaker Training Organization Richardton:** \$500 for WayMaker Training 2025 (traveling basketball teams)


## What is Our Potential?

There are over 69 local community foundations in North Dakota, some that started over three decades ago and others that started last year.

The larger these permanent endowment funds grow, the more earnings are available for grants every year. Some funds award over \$40,000 in grants every year!

Can you help us grow our fund so that we can better support the programs and projects that make Richardton-Taylor great? Consider setting up a recurring gift online or send a check to our address below.

- **Donate stock**
- **Make a Qualified Charitable Distribution (QCD) from your IRA** - sometimes called an IRA Charitable Rollover, your donation (directly from your IRA to NDCF for our fund) counts as your Required Minimum Distribution, but you can avoid taxes on it!
- **Give memorial gifts to our fund in honor of family members and friends.**
- **Donate agricultural commodities!** Just instruct your elevator or broker to donate a certain number of bushels or head of livestock to the North Dakota Community Foundation (for the Richardton Area Community Foundation). If you donate the commodity BEFORE it is sold, you don't have to count the sale as income AND you can deduct the cost of production.
- **Make the North Dakota Community Foundation (Tax ID#45-0336015), and specifically our fund, the beneficiary of your life insurance policy or a partial beneficiary of your estate.**
- **Take advantage of the tax credit.** Individuals that give at least \$5,000 in one calendar year and businesses that donate ANY amount to the Richardton Area

\$5 million+	Red	\$200,000+
\$1 million - \$5 M	Orange	\$40,000 - \$200,000
\$500,000 - \$999,999	Yellow	\$20,000 - \$40,000
\$250,000 - \$499,999	Light Green	\$10,000 - \$20,000
\$100,000 - \$249,999	Blue	\$4,000 - \$10,000
\$0 - \$99,999	Purple	\$0 - \$4,000

Community Foundation may take a 40% state income tax credit on their gift. This generous incentive can make a significant difference at tax time! Consult your tax advisor.
