- Leave a gift in your will you can leave a certain amount, a percentage of your estate, or the remainder of your estate (after designating gifts to family and friends).
- Individuals who donate at least \$5,000 in one calendar year and businesses that donate ANY amount (up to \$25,000) are eligible for the North Dakota 40% Income Tax Credit! (Anyone receiving income in North Dakota may qualify for the income tax credit, even if they live out of state.)
