Planned Giving Options

Along with regular donations, there are also opportunities to make planned gifts to the Bottineau Community Endowment Fund (BCEF) that may be of interest to our residents:

- PIRA Charitable Rollover Individuals that are 70 1/2 or older may make gifts of up to \$100,000 directly from their IRA to the North Dakota Community Foundation, benefiting the BCEF. You can avoid taxes on the amount you transfer and satisfy your required minimum distribution (RMD), if you are over 72.
- Charitable Gift Annuity (CGA) A Charitable Gift Annuity is a contract between a charity and an individual. The individual, referred to as the donor, transfers property to the NDCF for the BCEF and NDCF promises to pay a given amount at the end of each selected payment period to one annuitant for life or two annuitants for both lives (usually the donor or the donor and his/her spouse). The remaining principle is put in the BCEF when they pass.
- Bequest A bequest is property or money that you promise in your will to give to another person or organization after you die. If you would like to leave some or all of your estate to the BCEF, the bequest language is as follows:

"I give and bequeath to the North Dakota
Community Foundation (Tax ID 45-0336015), a
qualified charitable organization under IRS 501(c)
(3), located in Bismarck, North Dakota, ______(a
percentage of the estate, specific dollar amount, or
remainder of estate) to the Bottineau Community
Endowment Fund, a component fund of the North
Dakota Community Foundation."

Our Endowment Fund

In addition to our specific project funds, BACF has partnered with the North Dakota Community Foundation to establish the **Bottineau**



Community Endowment Fund. This permanent fund will provide long-term support for our community in the form of annual grants.

There are some unique benefits to donating to a qualified ND endowment fund. The most significant one is the 40% ND State Tax Credit.

Individuals that donate a minimum of \$5,000 and businesses that donate any amount up to \$50,000 in one calendar year to the **Bottineau Community Endowment Fund** may be eligible for a ND 40% State Tax Credit on their gift, up to \$10,000 in credit. This can add up to some significant cost savings on your gift, while providing perpetual support to our community!

The table below shows the cost of a gift to our endowment fund for donors in the 32% tax bracket.

Gift Amount:	\$5,000	\$25,000	\$50,000
Federal tax savings *	(\$960)	(\$4,800)	(\$9,600)
ND state income tax credit	(\$2,000)	(\$10,000)	(\$20,000)
Net cost of gift	\$2,040	\$10,200	\$20,400
