
- **New Salem Betterment Committee:** \$35,000 for a New Salem Welcome Sign

- **City of New Salem Commission:** \$11,982 to finish off the City Shop ceiling
- **New Salem Ambulance Service:** \$10,000 for equipment upgrades, training & medical kits
- **New Salem Park District:** \$7,500 for a warming house/utility shed for the ice rink
- **Missouri Slope Areawide United Way:** \$1,425 for the Dolly Parton Imagination Library


