- **Mountrail County Health Foundation:** \$40,000 for their Rosen Place on 8th Assisted Living facility (artists rendering shown below)




- **Opportunity Foundation, Inc.:** \$3,700 to provide autism services
- **S.A.C.K. (Stanley Area Cares for Kids):** \$2,500 to purchase backpacks of food for children for weekends and extended breaks
- **Flickertail Village Museum:** \$2,443 to replace shingles on five of the buildings in the Village
- **Stanley High School:** \$2,000 to build foundational set pieces for the drama program
- **The Sibyl Center for Life Enrichment:** \$1,300 for Children's Summer Theatre
- **Stanley High School Speech:** \$1,000 to help fund participation in national speech competitions

Where Have Our Grants Gone Over the Years?

The Stanley Area Community Foundation has awarded over \$220,182 in 64 different grants over the last 10 years to various organizations and entities in our area. Here is a breakdown of where those grant dollars have gone:

Park Board & Recreation Projects	\$54,735
Senior Services (Rosen Place, Bethel Home, etc.)	\$48,297
Health Foundation & Medical Center	\$30,300
Stanley Schools and Youth Projects	\$24,378
Human Services (e.g. Tri-City Cares, Mental Health)	\$22,750
Historical (Flickertail Village & Museum)	\$16,201
All Others (Sibyl Center, library, fire, food pantry)	\$23,521

Help Yourself, Help Your Community

If you would like to leave a gift to the Stanley Area Community Foundation, but still need some income now, consider a Charitable Gift Annuity.

You can take an asset (cash, stocks, an existing CD) and gift it to the North Dakota Community Foundation (NDCF - our partner) for the benefit of our community's endowment fund. You will then receive an annual payment for the rest of your life, based on your initial gift. The rates for gift annuities are particularly attractive in today's market place (see chart below)

A Charitable Gift Annuity provides assured and consistent income for you for retirement, healthcare, or other needs and also gives you the opportunity to leave a significant gift to our community when you are gone.

In addition to the increased income, you are entitled to take a current income tax charitable deduction and in certain cases a 40% ND Income Tax Credit for a percentage of the gift. The Annuity can pay you (and your spouse, if you choose) a lifetime income. Any remaining principal (after the last to receive income passes on) goes to benefitting your community.
