A Status Update for Donors and Supporters of Our Area's Permanent Endowment Fund.

Wow! The Mott-Regent Community Foundation has been making grants in our area since 2013 and what an impact it has had - check out the pie chart on the back to see where all our grant dollars have gone.

We are so thankful to Ishmael & Rose Diede, who started this fund with a gift in Ishmael's will. Now it is our responsibility to support this fund and grow it for future generations of residents.

We have more grant requests in our community than we can fund every year. Would you please consider making a donation this year? All of us together could grow this fund so that we can provide resources to our fire department, food pantry, park district and school forever.

It is a powerful thing to have an endowment fund that is **ONLY** for the Mott-Regent area - we are taking care of ourselves and our own needs instead of relying on outside sources of funding. But we need help in growing this fund.

There are many options for donating:

- Send a check to the address on the back
- Talk to your attorney and leave our community fund a gift in your will (It can be a certain dollar amount, a percentage of your estate, or the remainder of your estate after you've left gifts to family and friends.)
- Make our community fund the beneficiary of your life insurance policy
- Consider setting up a Charitable Gift Annuity and receive guaranteed payments for life - the remainder of your gift goes to our fund after you pass.

\$5,693 Awarded in 2019

A total of \$5,693 in 5 different grants was awarded to the following organizations in 2019:

- \$2,100 to **Regent Consumers Co-op** for their roof project



- \$1,137 to **the Mott Public Library** for a Children's Ready & Learning section upgrade and enhancement
- \$1,000 to the **Regent Ambulance Service** for a bathroom remodel for a handicapped shower room
- \$800 to the **Mott/Regent Public Schools** for a Second Floor AED Project
- \$656 to the **Mott Park District** for a Pool Blaster Pro 1500

4. Follow the instructions to complete the checkout process.


You will receive a tax receipt for your donation and you can change the amount or frequency of your gifts at any time.
